If you want to make a payment on your bill over the phone using a credit/debit card or check, you MUST call 1-844-219-1224.

Clark Electric Cooperative must move to the automated system in order to be compliant with the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standard.

These worldwide requirements

are designed to help companies that process such payments prevent credit card fraud through increased data controls. Moving to this system ensures our continued ability to accept debit and credit card payments.

The system is

automated, and all of your personal information, such as card number and payment amount, will be entered by YOU.

NO additional fee!

Before you call you need to have your account number handy.

After dialing you will go to the main menu. You'll be prompted to press numbers for the actions you wish to complete. At any time, you may hang up, which will discontinue the phone call.

You can also pay your bill online using SmartHub, Clark Electric's online bill payment system. SmartHub is a free app for computers and mobile devices providing you with secure account management right at your fingertips. For moble
