

RULES OF ORDER FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING

The Rules of Order for the Annual Meeting to be held April 14, 2020, at the American Legion Hall in Loyal, Wisconsin, have been set in accordance with the Section 8, Article III of the Clark Electric Cooperative Bylaws and are as follows:

1. The meeting will be conducted in accordance with the current edition of Robert’s Rules of Order and under the following special Rules of Order.
2. Members wishing to speak are asked to give their name(s) and the Town location in which they are members.
3. During nomination and election proceedings for director, candidates will be allowed to speak for four minutes; and one member supporting his/her candidacy will also be allowed to speak for four minutes.
4. Advisory Resolutions must be submitted to the Rules Committee, c/o of the CEO/GM, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Annual Meeting to give the Committee and the Board of Directors an opportunity to make a recommendation to the membership.
5. Other than individuals on the Annual Meeting program, only members will be allowed to speak for four minutes on each issue and for one time only except that an additional two minutes may be granted by 2/3 majority of the vote at the meeting.
6. No signs or handouts will be permitted within the building of the place of the meeting, except such handouts as required for the official conduct of the Annual Meeting.
7. No demonstrations shall be held within the building of the place of the meeting.

ANNUAL MEETING SET FOR APRIL 14, 2020

Clark Electric Cooperative’s Annual Meeting is scheduled for April 14, 2020, at the American Legion Hall in Loyal, Wisconsin starting at 9:30 a.m.

The annual meeting is an important event for the cooperative. Members will hear reports about the cooperative and the electric industry, review financials, conduct business, and elect their representatives to serve on the board of directors.

The members will be asked to elect two directors, for three-year terms. Director terms expiring this year are Jim Hager from the Town of Colby and Scott Johnson from the Town of Unity. Hager and Johnson are eligible for re-election. Nominations for the director positions are taken from the floor of the meeting. Any member advisory resolutions must be received by the cooperative at least 15 days before the date of the annual meeting.

The cooperative’s bylaws establish the minimum qualifications for being a director. A copy of the bylaws is available on the cooperative’s website at www.cecoop.com or by contacting the business office at 715-267-6188. If you have any additional questions about becoming a director, please contact Tim Stewart, CEO/GM, at the business office.

Directors are expected to attend monthly board meetings; represent the cooperative in state, regional, and national affairs; and take advantage of NRECA educational opportunities such as classes, seminars, and workshops. Directors need to read, study, and analyze a lot of information throughout the month to keep informed on the electric industry as a whole. Directors will spend approximately 20 to 35 days a year in performance of their duties. Plan to attend the annual meeting, enjoy a nice meal, register for door prizes, and help conduct the business of your electric utility. Member involvement is critically important to the success of your cooperative.

DIRECTORS RECENTLY EARN COOPERATIVE CREDENTIALS

For electric cooperatives to thrive in this time of change and uncertainty, it is vital that they have a solid understanding of the electric cooperative business model. They need a diverse set of knowledge and skills, up-to-date knowledge of industry changes, and a commitment to learn throughout their service on the board of directors.

The National Rural Electric Cooperative Association's Director Certificate Programs are specifically designed to help electric cooperative directors understand the complexity of a very challenging industry. The certification requirements consist of three parts as follows:

Credentialed Cooperative Director Certification (CCD) – The CCD is a set of five courses that focus on basic governance knowledge and the essential skills required of cooperative directors. The CCD prepares directors to fulfill their fiduciary duty as elected officials serving on behalf of their membership.

Board Leadership Certification (BLC) – After completing the CCD, and

as directors continue their board service, they need to stay current on industry issues and evolving expectations for governance. The BLC courses have been grouped into specialty areas such as power supply, finance, risk management, technology, and governance.

Director Gold Certification (DGC) – This credential recognizes directors who have earned their CCD and BLC credentials and are committed to continuing their education throughout their

service on the board. For a director to earn the DGC, they must hold the CCD and BLC and earn additional credits from the Board Leadership Certificate series of courses.

Congratulations to Directors Thomas Odeen for earning the CCD Certification; Scott Johnson, who earned the CCD & BLC Certifications; Marvin Verkuilen and Herman Seebandt, who each earned the Director Gold Program Re-Certification.

Sign Up for Text Messaging

Six Easy Steps

1. Go to our web site at www.cecoop.com. Under News/Events you will see a link that says outage text messaging and notifications—sign up here. Click that link.
2. This will take you to the sign-up page. You can watch a tutorial on how to sign up (**strongly recommended**) or you can start the process by clicking Introducing Outage Notifications.
3. End user terms and conditions of use comes up. Click Accept to continue.
4. The site will then ask you for your account and mobile phone number. Input those. **IMPORTANT:** Your phone number must be on file in order to sign up. If your phone number is not on file you will NOT be able to continue. You can email, call, or send us that information.
5. A verification code will be sent to your phone. Input that code.
6. Once inside the portal will bring up account summary. Click the blue pencil beside your account and follow instructions. That is all there is to it.

Texting an Outage

Once you're signed up for the service, just text Outage to 55050 to report your outage. Once your outage is restored, you will receive a text. If you have any questions please contact our office at 715-267-6188.
